- Treasurer's report was read as follows:

- Fundraising:
 - Purse Bingo – basket donations are needed.
 - Nina's Wings will be donating pizza and discounted wings for the Bingo
 - \$500 was raised for our scholarship program at the PNO.
 - John will confirm when info is due to the school for scholarships
- Football:
 - B Team currently has a waitlist of at least 9
 - Order has been placed with Battaglias
 - new jersey will be red with white stripes, NP on the front and Trojans on the back.
 - Order for the black and pink socks also placed.
 - Battaglias suggested we wait until they attend a trade show to order the extra shoulder pads. They will get back to us after regarding any deals.
 - We will also wait to order new pants. or next season.
- Cheerleading:
 - Coaches clinic will be held 6/24
 - \$25/coach and \$10/jr. coach
 - Topics covered will be competition rules, score sheets, choreo, safety, stunts
 - Teams counts are:

 - D Squad 17
 - Coaches meeting for football/cheer is tentatively scheduled for end of May (adult coaches only)
 - Bingo items:
 - Need to confirm Eagle McClure rules
 - Ashley Kamora will donate the required oil for the fryer
 - Rose will reach out to Slingshots for fries or pierogies donation
 - 12 cheerleaders confirmed for camp as of today. 174 bingo tickets confirmed sold.
- Vice President:
 - Waiting on game schedule to submit to the school for approval.

- President:
 - A tentative schedule I sin the works.
 - Joe Talarico is the new ACC president. ACC will need a new Seargent of Arms
 - Some of the votes at the last meeting were invalid because they did not go back to the organizations first. They will be re-voted at the next ACC meeting.
 - A new motion was made to divide the teams into 3 divisions, with the 3rd division made up of teams without an A team. The benefit would be to minimize travel that would divide A team from the rest of the teams on game days.
 - The 9-week season is still not official. We would vote to move the 1st game back 1 weeks if this approved because regular start date conflicts with our scheduled banquet.
 - Referees organization reported that having 3 referees instead of 4 might cause our price to go up even though we have a contract.
 - The fine for the cheerleading coordinators is still being discussed because they league does not have a history of fining organizations and is not sure they want to start.
 - Coach Dohlan's coaches meeting was postponed and new date is TBD.
- New Business:
 - Moriah will follow up with Battaglias for the new style of crop tops with the low collars. She will try to see if they can sell the old crops to one of the other teams.
 - We will need to reach out to Bishop soon to plan Picture Day.
 - Amy will check with insurance to see if all coaches need to sign an insurance letter this year.
 - Moriah reported that D Squad will be using our red uniforms this season to free up the black uniforms for the larger squads.
 - We have copies of the certificate of insurance to provide the bingo hall and the school district.

 - Ashley asked if we will need 6 adults in addition to Vickie Dunn for C Squad since she will not be available the entire season. Everyone agreed that would be the best plan.
